PROGRAMS OF INSTRUCTION

The Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree requires satisfactory completion of 42 semester hours of the Core Curriculum requirements of Areas A through E, completion of 18 semester hours of Area F requirements for **one** specific area of concentration of study, completion of 4 semester hours of physical education requirements, and completion of other requirements for graduation listed on pages -----. These degrees are for transfer to appropriate bachelor degree programs at senior colleges and universities. Students should consult transfer college catalogs for possible variations in these associate degree requirements.

THE CORE CURRICULUM

The Core Curriculum of the University System of Georgia was established for the general purpose of aiding and facilitating the educational progress of students as they pursue baccalaureate degrees with and among the units of the University System. It represents an effort to deal effectively with increasing curricular problems of students which result from increased enrollment at institutions of higher education, increased mobility of student population, increased number and complexity of major field of studies offered by senior units, and increased problems related to transfer of credit among units of the University System.

All courses satisfactorily completed in a Core Area of any unit of the University System will normally be acceptable and transferable to other units of the University System.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

The purpose of health and physical education classes at Waycross College is to develop skills and interest in activities that one can enjoy as life-time recreational pursuits. For the most part the classes involve individual or dual activities which require a minimum of facilities and equipment, but which can provide enjoyable recreational experiences throughout life.

All students enrolled in Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, and Associate of Applied Science degree programs must earn credit in a minimum of four semester hours in health and physical education. One of these must be PHED 1000: Personal and Community Health.

Veterans with twelve or more months of active military duty will receive two hours of physical education credit. The student must write a request for this credit and furnish a DD214 to the Vice President and Dean of Academic Affairs. Veterans are required to take PHED 1000. V.A. benefits will pay only for PHED 1000.

SECOND DEGREE

If a student has already earned one degree from Waycross College and would like to earn a second, the Program of Study for the second degree must be approved by the advisor for the new program and the Division Chair in which the program is offered.

Students wishing to pursue a second or subsequent Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree at Waycross College must have completed the 18 hours in Area F for the new degree, or in the case of duplication of courses in Area F, must complete a minimum of 18 semester hours that have not been used to satisfy the requirements of a previous degree. No more than 6 hours of the additional 18 hours can be from transfer work.

It should be noted that senior institutions limit the number of hours they will accept from a two-year college. Students who pursue a second degree may want to check with their senior institution.

Students wishing to pursue a second or subsequent Associate of Applied Science degree at Waycross College must have completed the graduation requirements of Altamaha Technical College (ATC) or Okefenokee Technical College (OTC) in the new option and must complete a minimum of seven additional hours at Waycross College from Areas C, D, or E from courses that have not been used to satisfy the requirements of a previous degree. If a student has already earned an Associate of Arts, or an Associate of Science degree, then the student cannot earn a subsequent Associate of Applied Science degree.

Students wishing to complete a second or subsequent certificate program at Waycross College must complete the additional courses for the certificate that were not used to satisfy the requirements of a previous certificate or degree. Students are not permitted to get a certificate after they have a degree if all the courses for the certificate have already been taken for the degree.
