Chicken and Pasta Soup

Ingredients

- 3 3/4 cups chicken stock
- 1 bay leaf
- 4 spring onions, sliced
- 8 oz. button mushrooms, sliced
- 4 oz. cooked chicken breast
- 2 oz. soup pasta
- 2/3 cup dry white wine
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh parsley
- Salt and black pepper



1. Put the stock and bay leaf into a pan and bring to a boil.
2. Add the spring onions and mushrooms to the stock.
3. Remove the skin from the chicken and slice the meat thinly using a sharp knife. Add to the soup and season to taste. Heat through for about 2-3 minutes.
4. Add the pasta, cover and simmer for 7-8 minutes. Just before serving add the wine and chopped parsley, heat through for 2-3 minutes, then season to taste.

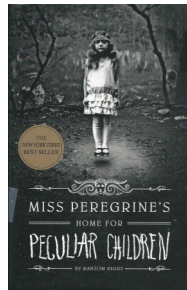

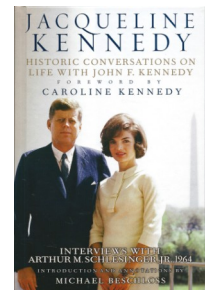
