Hot Spiced Cider Sachets

Each sachet can be added to 2qts of boiling water to make a great tasting hot drink.

- 6 cinnamon sticks 3" long
- 30 whole cardamom pods
- 30 whole cloves
- 18 crystallized ginger slices about 1" diameter
- 12 small bay leaves



Cut out six 5" squares of cheesecloth (muslin). Break the cinnamon sticks into pieces and divide them evenly among the squares. Place 5 cardamom pods, 5 cloves, 3 ginger slices, and 2 bay leaves atop each square. Bring the corners of each square together and tie with kitchen string, white thread or twine. Use immediately or store in an air-tight container for up to 2 months. Makes 6 sachets.

Did you know...

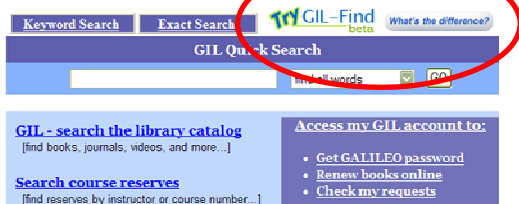
- 1) There is a New Title link on the library's homepage. Click on it to get the latest library purchases for your reading recreation and academic adventures.
