About the SAT On-Campus

The SAT On-Campus is an entry level college test used solely for students seeking admission into Waycross College.

Registering for the SAT

Cash, Check In-Person: Take Registration Form and fee to the Student Services Office in the Dye Student Service Building, Monday – Thursday 7:30 AM – 5:30 PM.

Check by Mail: Please include completed registration form and a check made payable to Waycross College. **Send your check, along with the complete registration form to:** Waycross College, Student Services, 2001 South Georgia Parkway, Waycross, Georgia 31503. To ensure timely processing of payment please mail **3 – 5 business days before** the payment deadline. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**

Registration Policy

Registration forms must be received by **12:00 PM** on the payment deadline. **No refunds or alternative testing dates will be provided.** For registration forms and payment that are mailed, please note that registrations must be **received, not postmarked** by 12:00 PM on the payment deadline. The SAT On-Campus may only be taken twice, scores may not be used for exemption on the Regent’s Exam.

On the Day of the Exam

Report to the Dye Student Services Building, no later than 5 minutes prior to your scheduled testing time. Late arrivals may be denied admission. Bring a government-issued ID or Waycross College Student ID, several #2 pencils, and a calculator, if you wish to use one on the mathematics sections of the test. Calculators will not be provided. Test sessions last approximately 4 hours.

Score Reporting

Tests will be scored no later than 2 business days following the test date. Score reports must be picked up in the Student Services Office, reports will not be mailed unless otherwise requested. Request forms will be provided immediately following your test.
